What's Involved?

Resident families spend 20-25 hours per week working on farm tasks. This includes upkeep of property and buildings, pool, welcoming guests and volunteers, and working as a team with other resident families.

The rhythm of farm life varies over the year, with some seasons being much busier than others..



Is this opportunity for your family?

Each resident family brings their own unique gifts, skills, and experience to the life of the farm.

The most important characteristic of a resident family, however, is love for God and neighbour, and a willingness to generously serve others, welcoming them without judgment.

Other qualities sought in a prospective family include:

- Strong work ethic
- Ability to work in a team
- Ability to plan, organize, and execute a wide variety of maintenance and administrative tasks
- Willingness to learn new skills
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills



Accommodations

There are four potential private residences on the farm. Each residence is fully winterized and equipped with basic appliances. Residents pay a modest rent as compensation for their unpaid service.



Community

Community is an important aspect of living at the farm. Resident families must be able to collaborate in running the farm, work with volunteers, and ideally enjoy building lasting friendships in the process.
